With the city budget deficit, city has decided to pull funding from the non-profit. There will be 3 more NROs in the beginning of the year and the plan is to have 7.

**City Council Report – Kitty Klitzke**. Budget is still the big thing being worked on. It is a tough decision. Kitty reminds us that city council only has so much say and that we should CC the mayor's office on as much communication as possible.

**STA Division BRT** - 2027 Construction will begin to increase mobility by delivering a high-quality, fast, frequent bus service for the Division Street corridor. There would be a bus-only lane created. Stations in our neighborhood would be Division and Francis Southbound/northbound, Division at Central Southbound/Northbound, and Division at Rowan Southbound/Northbound.
